Regulation

The processing of your personal data complies with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, i.e. the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

This information notice forms the basis of the data processing register and applies to the **Piroska guesthouse**, which is **operated by János Zélity, a sole trader and private accommodation provider**.

The protection of your personal data is very important to us. If you have any questions or would like to know more about data protection, please contact us at **zelityneerdei@gmail.com**.

The data controller shall take all necessary measures to ensure the secure and damage-free handling of data by protecting the confidentiality, integrity, and availability of the data. If the protection of your personal data is compromised and this is likely to result in a significant risk to your rights, we will notify you immediately.

When you contact us, for example, to request a quote, book accommodation, use a service, correspond with us, or fill out a form with your details, you acknowledge that we will process the data you provide during that contact in accordance with this Notice.

Your consent to data processing is voluntary, but it is necessary for the conclusion and performance of the contract, the provision of services, and compliance with legal obligations relating to the relevant payment.

You have the right to request the correction or deletion of your personal data, to object to data processing, to exercise your right to data portability, to request the restriction of data processing, to request access to your data, and to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority.

Personal data is any data or information that, alone or in combination with other data or information, can be used to directly or indirectly identify a specific person. **Your personal data primarily** includes your name, address, place and date of birth, mother's name, and personal identification number; these are known as personal identification data. However, any other data that, in combination with any of the above data, is capable of identifying you is also considered personal data (e.g., email address). **Some personal data, such as health data, enjoys special protection, but the Data Controller does not process such data.**

The data controller may be required to transfer certain data to the competent authority (e.g., the police) on the basis of a legal obligation or an official request. In the event of a data protection incident, i.e. when the data we process is accidentally or unlawfully destroyed, lost, altered, disclosed to third parties without authorization, or accessed by someone without authorization, it may be necessary to transfer certain data to the data protection authority.

Purpose of the planned processing of personal data and legal basis for data processing

a) Purpose: fulfillment of the contract or enforcement of the data controller's legitimate claim, if the data controller has a monetary claim against the data subject. The name and address data are also necessary for the data controller to issue a certificate. The telephone number/e-mail address is necessary so that the data controller can notify the data subject in connection with the performance of the contract.

b) claim:

- data processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or in order to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering into a contract;
- data processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by the controller;
- data processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation to which the controller is subject.
- With regard to email addresses and telephone numbers, the data subject declares that they consent to the processing of their personal data

With regard to the data to which they have given their consent, the data subject has the right to withdraw their consent at any time. The withdrawal of consent shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

Recipients of personal data and categories of recipients:

- **accountant** (for the purpose of providing ongoing accounting services to the data controller)
- **lawyer** (in the event that the data controller represents the data subject in or out of court)

The data controller does not transfer personal data to third countries or international organizations.

Duration of storage of personal data or, if this is not possible, criteria for determining this duration:

- continuously during the term of the contractual relationship,
- in the event of a contractual relationship:
 - if the contract is terminated, immediately upon termination of the legal relationship, with the exception of name and address,
 - if the contract is terminated but the data subject owes a debt to the data controller, in the fifth year from the date on which the last payment obligation became due,
 - if the contract is terminated and the data controller has issued a certificate, the name and address data shall be deleted by the data controller on the day following the expiry of the certificate retention period specified by law for the data controller, calculated from the date of issue.

The longer of these two storage periods shall apply.

Your rights:

You have the following rights regarding your personal data:

1. General rights

You have the right to obtain information about your data, to correct it, to delete it, to restrict its processing, to object to its processing, and to receive it in a portable format. If the processing of your data is based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent for the future.

2. Rights in the case of processing based on legitimate interests

Pursuant to Article 21(1) of the GDPR, you have the right to object at any time, on grounds relating to your particular situation, to the processing of personal data concerning you which is based on Article 6(1) (processing in the public interest) or Article 6(1)(f) (processing based on legitimate interests); this also applies to profiling based on this provision. If you object, we will no longer process your personal data unless we have compelling and legitimate grounds for doing so that override your interests, rights and freedoms, or if the processing is necessary for the establishment, exercise or defense of our legal claims.

3. Rights relating to direct marketing

If we process your personal data for direct marketing purposes, you have the right to object at any time to the processing of your personal data for such advertising purposes in accordance with Article 21(2) of the GDPR; this also applies to profiling insofar as it is related to such direct marketing.

If you object to the processing of your personal data for direct marketing purposes, we will no longer process your personal data for such purposes.

4. Right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority

You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the competent data protection supervisory authority regarding our processing of your personal data.

Contact us by email or contact form:

When you contact us via email or the contact form, we store the information you provide (your email address, possibly your name and telephone number) so that we can respond to your questions. If we ask you to provide information on our contact form that is not necessary for us to contact you, we always mark this information as "not required" (or "optional").

This data is used to verify your interest and improve the handling of your request. This data is collected on a strictly voluntary basis and with your consent - Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR. If this involves data relating to communication channels (e.g., your email address or telephone number), you also consent to us contacting you via this communication channel if necessary to answer your question. You can, of course, withdraw this consent at any time with future effect. We will delete the data arising in this context once it is no longer necessary to store it, or we will restrict its processing if its retention is required by law.

Data transmission

As a general rule, we will not disclose your data to third parties unless we are required to do so by law, or if the disclosure is necessary to fulfill our contractual obligations, or if you have given your prior express consent to the disclosure of your data.

External service providers and partner companies, such as online payment providers, will only receive your data if and to the extent necessary to process your order. In such cases, however, we will transfer as little data as possible. We ensure that if our service providers come into contact with your personal data, this is done in accordance with data protection regulations during the processing of the order in accordance with Article 28 of the GDPR. Please also note the privacy policy of the respective service provider. Although we make reasonable efforts to ensure that the services comply with legal requirements, the respective service provider is responsible for the content of services provided by third parties.

We emphasize that your data will be processed within the EU/EEA. However, we may use service providers that process data outside the EU/EEA. In such cases, we will ensure that the data recipient implements appropriate data protection measures before we transfer your personal data. This means that we achieve the desired level of data protection either on the basis of the EU's general terms and conditions or on the basis of measures that are considered comparable to the standards within the EU.

Data security

We have implemented extensive technical and operational security measures to protect your data from accidental or intentional manipulation, loss, destruction, and unauthorized access. We regularly review and update our security measures to keep pace with technological developments.

Acceptance and modification of the Privacy Policy

When booking private accommodation, Data Subjects accept the provisions of this Data Processing Notice. The Data Controller is entitled to unilaterally amend this Data Protection Notice. The amended Data Protection Notice will be published at the address of the guest house.

Terms

- **"personal data"** means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person ("data subject"); a natural person can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person
- **"processing"** means any operation or set of operations which is performed on personal data or on sets of personal data, whether or not by automated means, such as collection, recording, organization, structuring, storage, adaptation or alteration, retrieval, consultation, use, disclosure by transmission, dissemination or otherwise making available, alignment or combination, restriction, erasure or destruction;
- **"restriction of processing"**: marking stored personal data with a view to limiting their processing in the future;
- **"profiling"**: any form of automated processing of personal data consisting of the use of personal data to evaluate certain personal aspects relating to a natural person, in particular to analyze or predict aspects concerning that natural person's performance at work, economic situation, health, personal preferences, interests, reliability, behavior, location, or movements;
- **"filing system"**: any structured set of personal data, whether centralized, decentralized, or organized according to functional or geographical criteria, which is accessible according to specific criteria;
- **"controller"** means the natural or legal person, public authority, agency or any other body which, alone or jointly with others, determines the purposes and means of the processing of personal data; where the purposes and means of processing are determined by Union or Member State law, the controller or the specific criteria for its nomination may be provided for by Union or Member State law;
- **"processor"** means a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or any other body which processes personal data on behalf of the controller;
- **"recipient"**: a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or another body to which the personal data are disclosed, whether a third party or not.
- **"third party"**: a natural or legal person, public authority, agency or any other body other than the data subject, the controller, the processor and persons who, under the direct authority of the controller or processor, are authorized to process personal data;
- **"consent of the data subject"**: a freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous indication of the data subject's wishes by which he or she, by a statement or by a clear affirmative action, signifies agreement to the processing of personal data relating to him or her;
- **"personal data breach"** means a breach of security leading to the accidental or unlawful destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorized disclosure of, or access to, personal data transmitted, stored or otherwise processed;
- **"cross-border processing of personal data"** means the processing of personal data in the Union in the context of the activities of establishments in more than one Member State by a controller or processor in more than one Member State; or
- **processing of personal data in the Union which is carried out** in the context of the activities of a single establishment of a controller or processor and which substantially affects or is likely to substantially affect data subjects in more than one Member State
